



## Corona Art Association

### 2021 Art Show Rules

**Eligibility:** Shows are open to all current CAA members and the public. Work must be the original creation of the artist only, not a copy of any photograph, other than the artist's, taken by the artist and not have any direct content work by any other artist, class instructor or person. Reproductions (prints) of the artist's own work are allowed and must be noted as such.

**Age of work:** Artwork for competition or theme shows must have been created within the past five (5) years. Due to the current size of the association and the Covid19 Pandemic, this rule is discretionary based on the number of Art Show entries. Artwork over five years old will be accepted, as space allows.

#### **Specifications:**

- Two-dimensional artwork measuring 36" wide by 40" high to a maximum of 48" wide by 54" high including the frame is limited to one per artist.
- All hanging work must be properly wired for hanging with screw eyes or D-Rings and suitable wire. Saw-tooth clamps or fold out flaps are not acceptable.
- Work must be dry, clean, undamaged, and finished. Works on paper must be matted and under glass or Plexiglass. Paintings on wrap around canvas must be painted on all sides and edges with no staples visible.
- All artwork must have a label securely attached to the back of the piece with the artist's name, phone number, title of piece, medium and price or NFS (not for sale.)

#### **Fees:**

- Members may enter up to four (4) pieces at the current entry fee unless otherwise stated. Members who Gallery sit or volunteer to support CAA events, for a minimum of four hours each month are eligible for a reduced rate entry fee.
- Non-members may enter up to four (4) pieces at the current non-member entry fee.

**Judging:** Works accepted by the Show Committee will be judged by an independent judge contracted by the CAA, or by a Popular Vote by CAA members, as determined by the CAA Board. Artwork not fitting the show theme, as determined by the judge, shall not be eligible for awards or prizes. Works that have had won Best of Show or First Place in a prior CAA show are not eligible for entry in subsequent shows unless otherwise stated. Cash prizes will be awarded when financially feasible, as determined by the CAA Board.

#### Art Show Take-in/out procedures:

Artwork may be entered into the show during regular gallery hours, Thursday through Sunday, between the hours of 12-4. **Gallery sitters** will act as **Gallery Coordinators on Art Show Take in weekends**. They will be available to accept your artwork and return any artwork from the last show.

The **Art Show Installer**, under the direction of the Director at Large who supervises this committee, will meet after 4:00 p.m. on the last day of take-in or within two days, to determine how the art show will be presented.

All artwork must remain on display throughout the duration of the show. If someone other than the artist picks up the work, written permission must be provided by the artist. If you cannot pick up your art within 30 days after the designated pickup dates, please contact the Gallery. Artwork left 30 days after the pickup date will be considered a donation to the CAA and becomes the property of the CAA.

**Art Show Themes:** Themes will be selected by the membership by a vote in October for the following year. Art show themes will be announced at the December General Meeting.

**Sales, Liability, and Reserved Rights:**

- The CAA receives a 25% donation of all sales.
- Reasonable care will be taken to assure proper handling of entries to prevent damage. Artists entering work in the CAA Gallery or other CAA sponsored venues accept full responsibility for their work.
- The CAA, its membership, the City of Corona, off-site venues, their employees, and volunteers, may not be held responsible for any loss of damage of your artwork.
- Acceptance of work is at the discretion of the Art Show Committee. The CAA reserves the right to reject any artwork not meeting the requirements, work that creates a liability issue or that is not appropriate for our City of Corona facility.
