Corona Art Association's Gallery Gift Shop Coordinator, Lani Britain, comes from a strong family background of talented artists, including her mother and grandmother. So, it's no wonder that her elementary school teachers noticed her own artistic talent. Although being recognized in class made her feel selfconscious, it also fueled her interest in art.

Lani's mediums of choice include a variety of 2-D applications, including oils, watercolors, acrylics, pastels, pencil, and charcoal. She finds the most satisfaction working with acrylics, however, she does love the challenge of watercolors! She credits CAA's own Mary Lou Wallace, for giving her the encouragement to experiment with watercolors and to always "practice, practice, practice!" Additionally, Lani is an avid photographer and gardener. When given a theme or creative assignment, she draws inspiration from her family and nature photography, as well as the flowers and plants that surround her. Lani's creative talents seem to know no limits, as she is also an accomplished seamstress, having owned and operated a costume rental business for 13 years. Lani has taught sewing and planting for CAA, as well as opened her fantastical garden to our members for plein air painting.

Lani's favorite artists are Maxfield Parrish, Norman Rockwell, and Erte. Parrish for his mythical, magical lands and characters and beautiful skies and clouds. Rockwell for his way of portraying the everyday life of everyday people in his time, often with humor. And she loves Erte for his glamorous and dramatic designs and referred to his work often when she was making costumes.

When reflecting on what she hopes her art brings to the world, she says, "happiness, joy, and an appreciation for all of the wonders of nature and the natural world".
